Alderman Mike Whitlock also announced that Main Street Manager Tanya Capps had called him and told him that the City was also awarded the DOTD grant for \$225,000 for sidewalks and additional lighting in the downtown area that had been applied for earlier in the year. Mayor Huddleston said he was looking into that and running everything by the City Attorney and City Engineer before he brought that to the Council.
